It is time to submit recommendations to the Nominating Committee for the slate of Trustees for the American College of Cardiology (ACC) and the American College of Cardiology Foundation (ACCF), who will be elected at the Annual Business Meeting in March 2017 in Washington, DC. Trustees can serve in both organizations for the duration of their terms. The deadline for receipt of recommendations is October 16, 2016.

Your recommendations are invited for the position of Trustee. Each Trustee will serve up to a three-year term.

Please review the nomination and application materials located at [www.acc.org/BOTnominations](http://www.acc.org/BOTnominations). In making recommendations, you are reminded of the following:

- Members may be primary nominator for only one member per category (Officer or Trustee).
- Members may write a letter of support for up to two Trustees, provided they are not the primary nominator of a Trustee.
- Officers, Nominating Committee members and staff may not support a candidate.
- A Past-President is ineligible for any elected office.
- Members of the Nominating Committee are ineligible for any office.
- Members who have served a five-year term as a Trustee are ineligible to serve again as a Trustee.
- Members of the Board of Governors may not serve on the Board of Trustees concurrently.

The Nominating Committee will meet this fall to consider all recommendations submitted and will present a slate of nominations to the ACC/ACCF Board of Trustees for approval. The Nominating Committee is chaired by Kim Allan Williams, Sr., MD, MACC.
