
History of NYCVS

- Begun in 1967/1968 by Henry Irving Russek, MD, FACC
- Other than Annual Scientific Sessions, ACC's oldest and largest educational program
- Russek's final program was:
 "Changes, Choices, Challenges in the Management of Cardiovascular Disease"
- Valentin Fuster, MD, FACC stepped in Following Russek's passing in 1990









Travel Award Named After NYCVS Founder, Russek

- Henry I. Russek Travel Awards for FITs and Medical Students
- The award honors Dr. Henry I. Russek, who served as director of the NYCVS for 25 years
- The award provides funding for eight FIT members and five medical students from NJ, NY, or CT with an interest in cardiovascular medicine to attend this seminar.




NYCVS 2016 Attendees by Continent/Region (as of 11/30/16)
