He is also one of the foremost experts in clinical trials, with more than 1,200 peer-reviewed publications.

The College is proud to claim Dr. Califf as one of its most distinguished members. His contributions to the field of cardiology and his commitment to patient care would only be magnified should he be confirmed for another stint as Commissioner. The ACC strongly supports Dr. Califf for commissioner of the FDA.
