Navigating the Home Screen

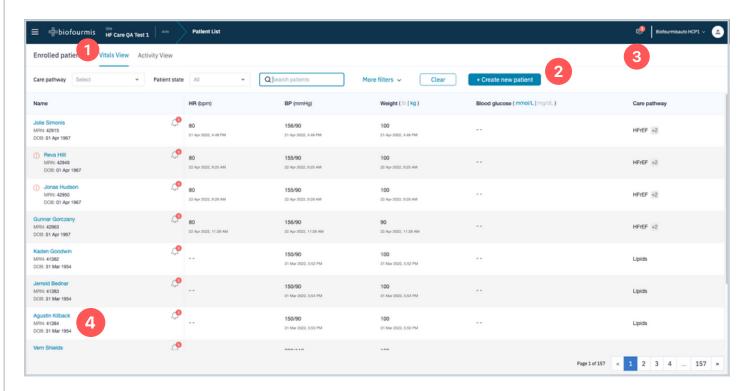
Once a study participant is enrolled, you can begin to monitor them on the web dashboard. See below for information about navigating the home screen.



Home Screen Vitals View

The "Vitals View" displays the most recent vitals for the study participants on the "Patients list" page. Any active vital sign alert will display in the column next to the vital sign value that triggered the alert and will be indicated with a red alert icon.

Read the callouts below:



- 1. **Biofourmis logo:** Click the Biofourmis logo at any time to return to the home screen.
- 2. Create new patient: Click to begin adding a new study participant.
- 3. **Communication:** View and respond to incoming messages from patients.
- 4. **Patient information:** View patient name, medical record number, and date of birth. Click the patient's name to access their patient details page.

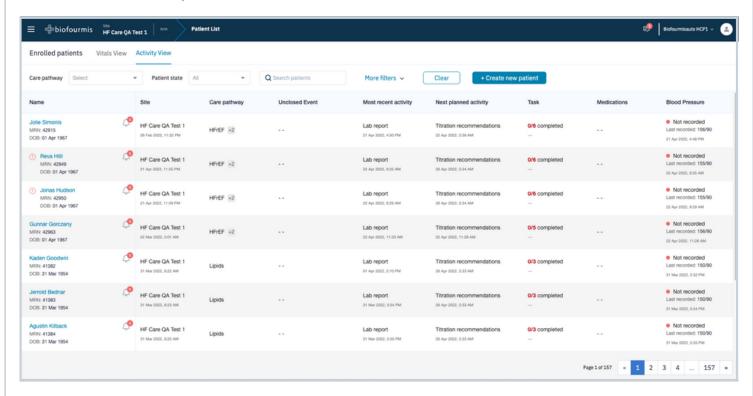
Navigating the Home Screen



Home Screen Activity View

The "Activity View" will display the actions and events on the "Patients list" page, including vital sign events, the patient's most recent and upcoming activities, the status of the patient's completed daily tasks, and the compliance of the patient's assigned medications.

See the column descriptions below:



- 1. **Care pathway:** This column shows the care path assigned to the study participant based on their condition.
- 2. **Unclosed events:** This column shows all open vital sign events for the study participant.
- 3. **Most recent activity:** This column shows the last completed activity by the study participant.
- 4. Next planned activity: This column shows the next activity for the study participant.
- 5. **Task:** This column shows the number of tasks completed by the study participant.
- 6. **Medications:** This column shows how many of the prescribed medications the study participant has taken.
- 7. **Blood Pressure:** This column shows the last recorded blood pressure value for the study participant.
