
Once a study participant is enrolled, you can begin to monitor them on the web dashboard. See below for steps to access and manage the "Patient details" page.



Step 1

On the home screen, click on the study participant's name to open their "Patient details" page.

Note: You can also search for a study participant by typing their name in the search bar at the top of your screen.




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Once you have clicked on a study participant, the "Patient details" screen appears. From this page, you can access information about the study participant's vital signs, medications, clinical notes, and more.



Patient Details Page



- 1. **Data tabs:** Across this banner are different sections of the patient record you can access. Click a tab to open its section. See below for information about each section.
 - a. *Biometrics*: This page displays the vital signs for the study participant within individual graphs. Open and closed events can also be viewed in the event report pane.
 - b. *Medications*: This page allows you to view and edit the study participant's current medication plan.

 Open and closed titration recommendations can also be viewed in the titration recommendation pane.
 - c. *Lab Reports*: This page displays the study participant's last updated lab values. New lab reports can be updated to the dashboard using the "Add new lab report" pane.
 - d. *Evaluations*: This page displays study participant questionnaire responses in graphs. The responses to individual questions can be viewed in the questionnaire pane.
 - e. *Information*: This page displays the medical history of the study participant and the patient logs that show all activities related to the study participant.
- 2. **Action icons:** The action icons on the far right of the screen offer additional tools to successfully manage your study participants.
 - a. *Chat icon*: The chat icon allows you to initiate communication with the study participant through both video calling and chat text messaging.
 - b. *Thresholds icon*: The thresholds icon allows you to adjust the individual study participant's vital sign thresholds.
