



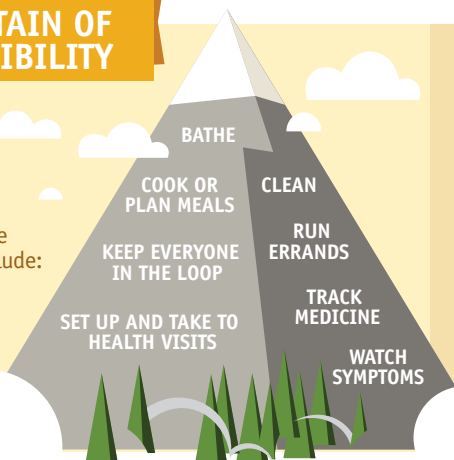
▶ **CARING FOR A LOVED ONE CAN BE AN HONOR**
