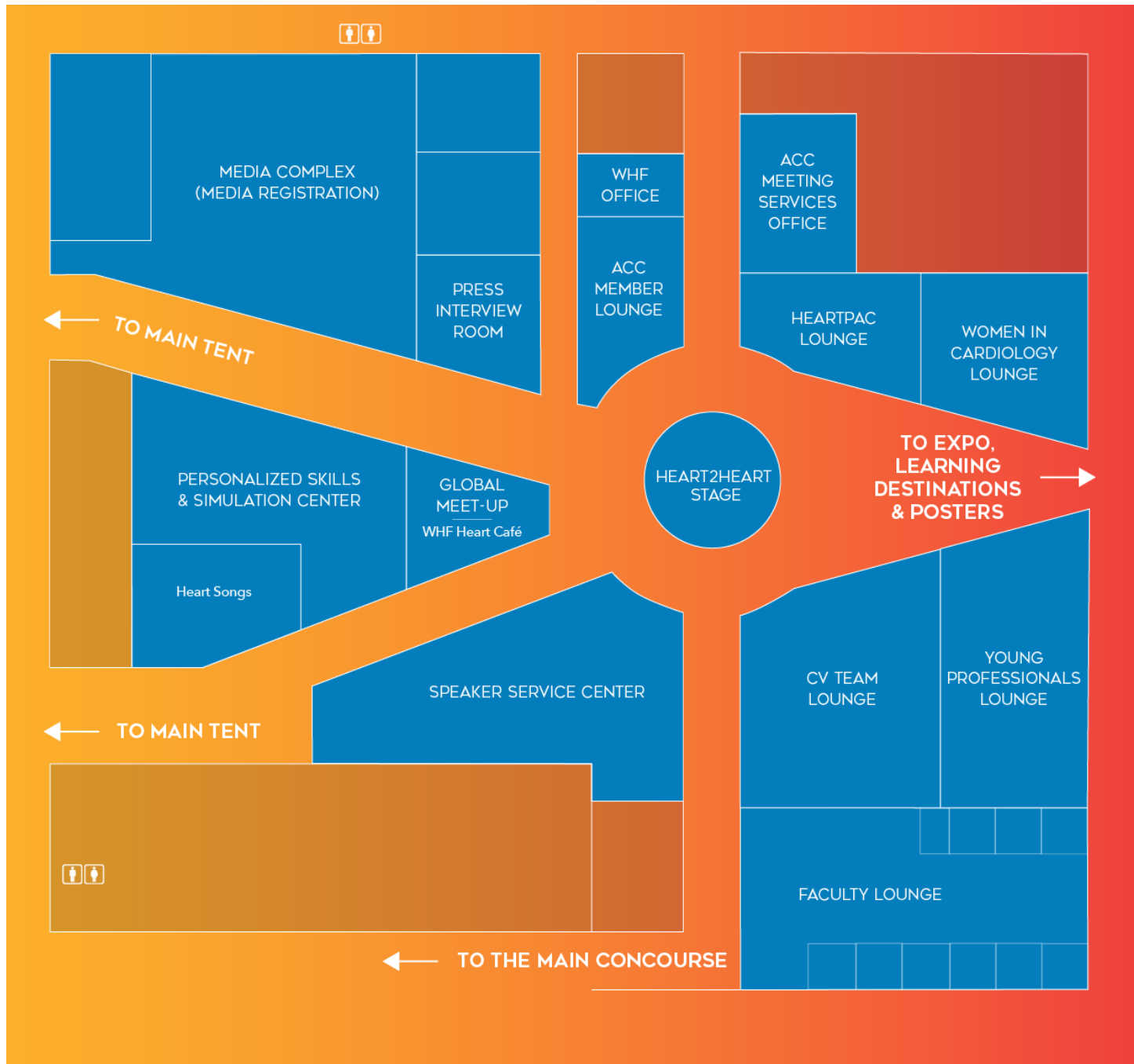
The Center includes:

- **Heart Songs**
Focus on physical exam skills including auscultation with Bluetooth stethoscopes and Point-of-Care echo and try out both these devices on live models. With a choice of 3 modules – common, advanced or expert murmurs – view hi-definition videos of phonocardiograms and color Doppler echo images while listening to a variety of heart murmurs.
- **Learn by Doing: Immersive Simulation Experiences**
Guided by expert faculty, choose from six simulation experiences that include telemedicine, hypertrophic

cardiomyopathy (standardized patients including real-time echocardiography), syncope evaluation and management, ICM and transvenous pacing, as well as a 4-station CICU including POCUS, PAC, MCS and pericardiocentesis. You can also hone your communication skills as you provide counseling and shared decision-making discussions at several stations.

- **The Red Flag Work-up: Syncope Guidelines in Action**
Clinicians seeing a patient with any transient loss of consciousness need a systematic evaluation approach that allows them to distinguish critical syncope from a non-critical syncopal event, identify the underlying mechanism, and determine the future risk for recurrence and severe adverse events. The assessment and management of syncope requires a nuanced approach for older adults, pediatric patients, and athletes. Using a standardized patient, this session will demonstrate how to perform the "red-flag" work-up as well as the subsequent patient counseling that should occur.
- **HCM Obstruction to Sudden Death: Novel Approaches to Treatment**
Guided by HCM experts, immerse yourself in hypertrophic cardiomyopathy case-based learning. Engage in real-time assessment, diagnostic and treatment planning with our standardized patient in this intimate setting.
- **Lonely Nights in the CICU: The Key Troubleshooting Skills Required**
It seems the call always happens at 2 a.m.! Join our critical care experts in this case-based learning session as they review the key troubleshooting skills required during those lonely nights in the CICU. This includes POCUS and the ABC of the Pulmonary Survival Tips for the PAC and Mechanical Circulatory Support and pericardiocentesis.

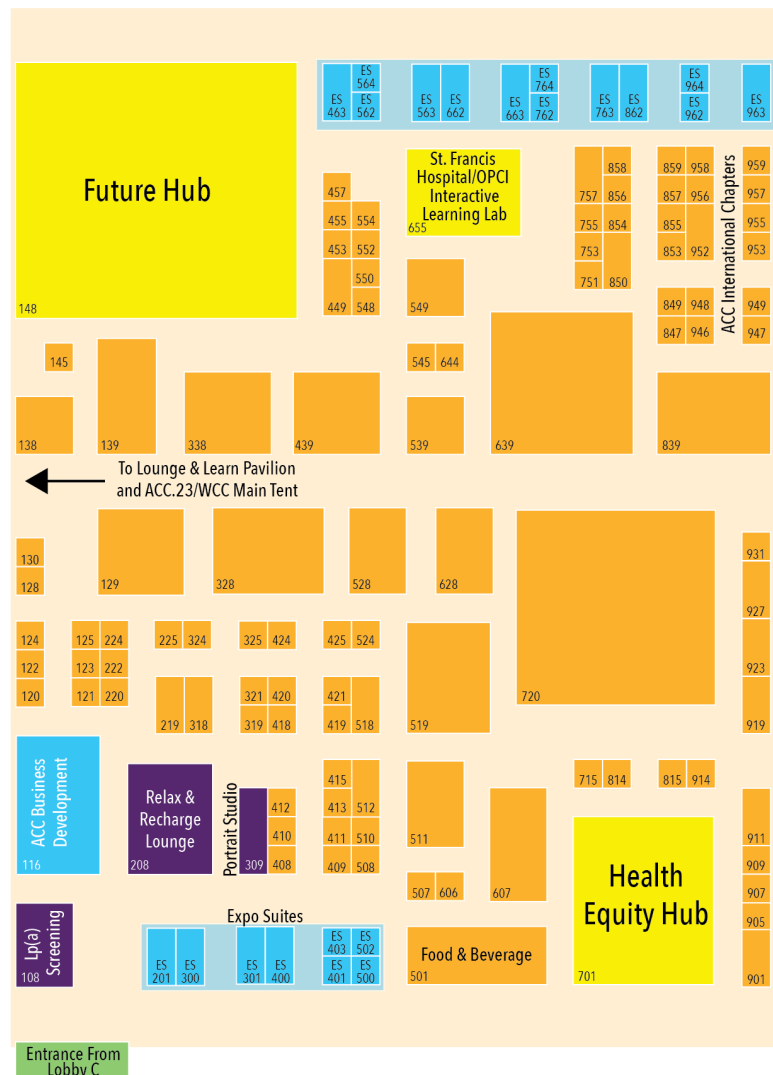



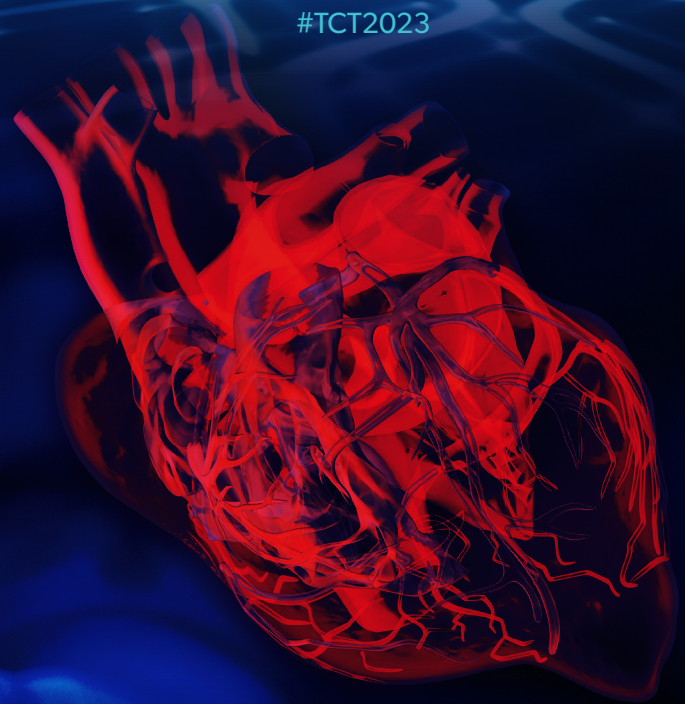
