



ACC.26 Credit Claim Frequently Asked Questions

I am attended ACC.26 in person, how do I get assistance with the credit claiming and evaluation process?

Refer to the 8-step credit claiming instructions and these FAQs for answers to your questions regarding credit claiming. You may also contact [Member Care](#) for support.

I am participating in ACC.26@Home (Virtual), who should I contact for help with the credit claiming and evaluation process?

Credit for ACC.26@Home (Virtual) attendees is being issued through a separate system. Virtual attendees should [click here to claim credit](#). You must use the email address you used to register for ACC.26@Home. For additional information, please see the ACC.26@Home FAQs below. If you have questions, please contact [Member Care](#).

How do I login to the Credit System?

Open the **ACC.26 App** or visit ACCScientificSession.org/Credit and select **Claim Credit**. If you are not automatically logged in, then click the link to **Log in to Your ACC Account**. You must use the same ACC username and password you used to register for ACC.26.

I forgot my ACC username and/or password. How can I retrieve that information?

When prompted to login, choose the **Forgot Password** feature to reset your password. In most cases, your username is your email address. If you are still unable to log in, stop by the Tech Help Desk for personal assistance or contact ACC Member Care after the meeting.

Is there a deadline for claiming credit?

Yes. The deadline to claim credit or a certificate of participation is **June 30, 2026, at 5 p.m. ET**, however we recommend you claim at the conclusion of ACC.26. **Please note that the deadline to claim credit for pharmacist is May 29, 2026.**

I can log into the ACC.26 Credit System, but I don't see anything related to credits.

The credit claim options can only be seen by those who have purchased an ACC.26 registration AND have a professional registration category (Physician, Nurse, Physician Assistant, Pharmacist, Other). If you fall into both categories and you are still unable to view the credit claim options or you don't see the credit



type that should apply to your professional category, stop by the Tech Help Desk or contact ACC Member Care.

How many credits may I claim?

ACC.26 has been designated for up to the following credit maximums and credit should be claimed based on participation:

- 21.75 AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™
- 21.75 Medical Knowledge MOC points in the American Board of Internal Medicine's (ABIM) Maintenance of Certification (MOC) program
- 21.75 MOC points in the American Board of Pediatrics (ABP) Maintenance of Certification (MOC) program
- 21.75 continuing nursing education contact hours and 11.00 continuing nursing pharmacology credit hours
- 21.75 AAPA Category 1 CME credits
- 21.75 contact hours (20.25 CEUs) of the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education
- 14.00 Interprofessional Continuing Education (IPCE) credits
- 21.75 American Society of Radiologic Technologist (ASRT) CE credits

Why were some sessions in My Credit/Participation Cart not included in the sessions list on my certificate?

The sessions list includes only those sessions certified for credit.

How do I earn ABIM/ABP MOC points?

ABIM/ABP MOC will be offered for select sessions, designed within the ABIM/ABP framework. During sessions offering MOC points, attendees should actively participate and are asked to complete the short session evaluation.

Who can claim ABIM/ABP MOC points?

The opportunity to earn ABIM/ABP MOC points is open to physicians who are ABIM/ABP Diplomates; however, attendance at these sessions is open to all interested clinicians. ABIM/ABP Diplomates will be required to provide their accurate ABIM diplomate number and birth date (month/date – mm/dd) to claim ABIM/ABP MOC points. How can I obtain a Certificate of Participation?

Follow the 8-step process on the front of this flier. Once you have finalized your cart, select the **Certificate of Participation** or **Certificate of Participation with Sessions List** under **Available Certificates** on the right side of the page. Complete the overall evaluation and generate your certificate.

Can I claim a Certificate of Participation in addition to my certificate of credit?

Yes.

How do I access presenter disclosures?
